SHARED FEATURES (BOTH IPAD AND ANDROID TABLETS)

- Selectable map views, such as Autoplay, Flight Preview, Total Route and Mid Flight
- Command Center multi-panel view that provides several interactive elements, including different map scenes, flight data banners and a 3D aircraft over a compass
- 3D Time Zone Globe a rotating globe that displays the time zones of the world. Using gestures, rotate the globe to see different areas of the globe or pinch and zoon to get a closer look
- World Clocks select up to nine cities to see the current time, population, elevation and distance from the aircraft
- Custom aircraft symbol and paint scheme to add a personalized touch
- Day and night sky views align with the time of day at your present location
- > Customized settings for personalized viewing preferences
- Download directly from the Apple App Store (iPad) or from Google Play (Android tablets)

 > 3D Relative Location Indicator - Compass points north as the aircraft points in the direction of the flight path while displaying the distance of two cities from the current position. In Settings Editor, passengers may select from a list of over 300 cities.

Features for iPad

- Panorama experience the world beyond the cabin, as if looking through a transparent cabin
- > Utilizes NASA's Blue Marble map set

Features for Android Tablets

- Touchscreen gesture controls in the map (pinch to zoom, pan, rotate, swipe, etc.) for a fully interactive experience
- Roam button allows you to navigate the interactive map away from the current flight path of the aircraft
- Left window, right window and front HUD selectable window views
- > Utilizes Landset 7 mapset



HOW DOES IT WORK?

The Airshow app receives flight data broadcast from the aircraft's installed Airshow system, which is connected to a wireless cabin network.



WHAT DO I NEED?

The Airshow app is available for the following tablet devices:

- > iPad version 2 and later
- > Android tablet version 4.1 or later

An on-board Airshow system that is connected to the aircraft's flight management system and wireless cabin network, and is compatible with the Airshow app. Compatible Airshow systems:

- > Airshow 4000 Mod B with Service Pack 5.2 or later
- > Airshow on Media Center in Venue[™], version 4.2 or later
- Airshow on HTSE/HD AV in Venue[™], version 6.1 or later
- > Version 9 software on the Bombardier Global Express
- > Airshow 500

A modified Airshow configuration to enable the app's access to flight data

The Airshow app from iTunes loaded onto an iPad or from the Google Play Store loaded onto an Android tablet

HOW DO I CONNECT THE AIRSHOW SYSTEM TO A WIRELESS NETWORK?
